Through the Adopt-A-Park program, your group can make a commitment to the community by becoming a partner in the care and beautification of our parks. It is a great opportunity for anyone ... individuals, businesses, and community organizations ... with a love for nature and sincere interest in their community to make a difference. We are looking for people interested in adopting a park to commit to keeping their designated park clean by planting flowers, picking up trash, and weeding beds.





The rewards are endless:

- A sense of accomplishment
- A sense of community pride and ownership
- The opportunity to make a visible difference
- Keep community fees stable





ADOPT-A-PARK VOLUNTEER RESPONSIBILITES:

Adopt-A-Park partners shall:

- Commit to adopt a park for a minimum of two (2) years. Multiple groups are welcome to join together as one unit to adopt a park.
- Commit to cleaning up the adopted park at least 2 times a year (preferably 4 times a year).
- Fill out and sign the adoption application form.
- Notify the Ocean Pines Recreation and Parks Department of the date, time, and location of work to be done in the adopted area at least 2 weeks in advance of the intended start of work.
- Provide all tools, materials, and supplies (other than trash bags) needed to complete the work.
- Pick up trash bags from the Ocean Pines Community Center during regular business hours at least 1 day prior to the clean-up day.
- Return any unused trash bags to the Ocean Pines Community Center as soon as possible.
- Place litter in trash bags provided and deposit fill trash bags in the designated spot at the park for pick-up.

Adopt-A-Park partners shall NOT:

- Made additions to park property without written request to and approved by the Recreation and Parks director.
- Perform work on areas not directly in the assigned park.
- Sub contract or assign duties or responsibilities to any other group or organization.
- Conduct activities during hazardous weather conditions.

Activity Suggestions:

- Pick up trash.
- Spring clean up.
- Maintain mulch and woodchip trails and paths.
- Improve landscaping by planting shrubs and flowers, weeding, and mulching beds and trees.
- Pile fallen branches and rake leaves.

Ocean Pines Recreation and Parks will:

- Approve/make recommendations on Adopt-A-Park applications.
- Erect signs at the adopted park displaying the Adopt-A-Park log and name of the Adopt-A-Park partner.
- Remove filled garbage bags and piled limbs and leaves from the adopted area as soon as practical after the litter collection is completed.
- Maintain the right to terminate the adoption if the partner does not meet the terms and conditions of the agreement.
