- A great power point presentation by Frank Piorko, the Executive Director for MCBP, and Zachary of the MCBP on our watershed (D+ rating). Ocean Pines is the primary population base in the watershed.
- Zachary reported that of the 130 water testing bottles he received 98 back for testing. That is a 75% response which is very good. Wants to keep water testing in Ocean Pines going in the future.
- Discussed the CAFO with MCBP who proposed putting both sides together at a meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Discussed floating wetlands which are working well in South Bethany canals improving water quality. All felt this might be a good approach for Ocean Pines.
- Discussed ways to improve Bay Days for next year. Ways to raise funding for it.
