- **1968** Road construction begins, July 12 Opening Day of Sales
- **1969** Boise Cascade purchases land total acreage of 3,500
 - First home sold to John & Mickey King
- 1970 First year-round residents (Jerome & Gloria Richards) occupy home
 - Route 90 opens
- 1971 Beach Club, Swim & Racquet Club and Equestrian Center open
- **1972** 18-hole golf course opens, OPA formed
- **1974** Community Hall built
- **1975** Yacht Club & Marina built
 - Sports Core Pool and tennis courts open

















A community grows....

- 2003 Community fundraising efforts led by resident Barbara Kissel and volunteers results in Manklin Meadows playground






