TOPIC: Update on Flight Turf ENA Proposal.

CONCISE STATEMENT: The ENA Committee will re-examine past options including getting more information on a vegetation buffer around the ponds which produces a less attractive atmosphere for the migratory Canada geese thus discouraging their becoming permanent residents. A similar program was enacted during the winter and spring seasons of 2014-2015 resulting in some success. These grasses and vegetation also reduce soil erosion and helping to mitigate nitrogen and phosphorus. It is the Committee's hope that by discoursing the migratory population of the Canada geese from becoming resident geese we can avoid the possibility of more drastic remedies like euthanasia.

BACKGROUND:

07/28 ENA passed Motion (8/1) to present Flight Turf test proposal to the Board.

09/15: Past Liaison presented Board with packet and Board asked for more information regarding past remediation attempts and costs.

10/11: New Board Liaison appointed. Flight Turf is not on agenda as past Liaison did not provide "outline" or request it to be on agenda for 10/16. Present Liaison contacted the ENA committee.

10/16: Board Meeting did not include Flight Tuff

10/19: Present Liaison submitted a charging document to ENA Committee

10/27: ENA Committee meets. John Viola, Justin Hartshorne and Eddie Wells in attendance to discuss Flight Turf.

DISCUSSION:

1 acre seed is \$2,600. Cost to seed includes spraying plant killer, removing plants, working seed & fertilizer = \$6,000-\$10,000 acre. Recommendation is to do the entire North Pond area or the geese will just shift over. North Pond costs (3-4 acres) = \$45,000-\$65,000. South Pond estimate (6-7 acres) \$70,000. Total estimated costs is \$120,000.

TOPIC: North Gate Bridge Clean Up

CONCISE STATEMENT: Homeowners complaints regarding the appearance of the North Gate Bridge entryway and their suggestions for improving its appearance.

BACKGROUND: The North Gate bridge entryway is one of the major entry points into Ocean Pines. Normal wear and tear, a number of vehicle-bridge accidents, weather related factors and littering have taken a toll on its appearance. The purpose of this discussion is to determine what can be done to improve the appearance of this main entryway into the community. Here are the comments that we received from a member of the community...

"Over the past several years, the north entrance has become an eyesore. This is quite disconcerting to those of us who live on the north side, and who view the north entrance on a daily basis. The entrance to our community is like the front yard to one's house and in its current state, it is an embarrassment. The current appearance indicates a community that takes little pride in its appearance and has no concern with its curb appeal. Some of the most obvious issues are: •Mold growing on the shingle roof of the guard house. •Wood shingle siding has cracks and mold growing and is in dire need of replacement or a good stain job. •Debris under the bridge that is visible when waiting at the light. • Multiple cuts and gashes in the wood from cars misjudging the entrance and width of the bridge. • Wood that is faded, and recent repairs that are sticking out like a sore thumb. • Multiple missing, broken and filthy lights that all should be replaced with something more up to date, aesthetically pleasing and functional"

Specifically I would like to propose, and discuss, shutting down the North entryway for several days, diverting traffic to the Beauchamp Road entryway, power washing and staining the bridge and guard house, cleaning the surrounding trash, repairing/replacing the lighting to make it uniform and placing a holiday display in the guard house during the upcoming holiday season.

 - (i) An action may not be taken and a matter may not be discussed if it is not permitted by paragraph (4) of this section; and
