Call to Order

Chair Carol Ludwig called the meeting to order at 10 am.

Verification of quorum and volunteer to take of minutes

Unfinished Business

While the voting package will be sent the week of July 12, the committee is waiting for a decision by the Board of Directors on whether there will be a hybrid annual meeting and how it will be conducted to be able to complete the election package to be mailed to residents.

New Business

Review paper and electronic ballot instructions for mailing

The committee discussed changes to a draft version of the voting instructions document. It was agreed that Vote HOA would not send residents an email on electronic voting; all instructions would be sent out by mail with paper ballot and the notice of the annual meeting. The information to be sent out will include details on how to contact Vote HOA for electronic voting.

There was also discussion of the process of methods for checking for duplicate paper ballots. Elections Committee Members will check the unopened paper ballots to verify, via the lot/section number on the reply envelope, if online voting was also used. Reply envelopes with lot/section obscured in any way will be deemed invalid.

Review Committee Member duties for Annual Meeting

Committee members will check in residents in-person and verify that they are eligible voters for purposes of determining a quorum. The committee will ask Membership and IT departments for a list of residents, highlighting those that are eligible voters for this purpose. If there is a hybrid meeting, a committee member will need to check that the person online is a registered voter before they are accepted into the meeting.

Review M06 and updates to B03 for Hybrid Annual Meeting

We are awaiting final decisions from the Board on the Hybrid Annual Meeting.
